SUBJECT: 12B10 MOS-T Welcome Letter

Congratulations on your selection to attend the 12B10 MOS-T course at our Academy. We are proud to offer you an opportunity to attend this course. Our motto is: "Morte Magis Metuenda." The following information will assist you in preparing for the course.

### 1. REPORT DATE:

a. All students will report NLT 1200 hours on your scheduled report day to the main entrance of the RTI Building 3800 – Room 236. Sign-in begins at 0800. There are signs in the main corridor to assist you in locating 1<sup>ST</sup> BN (EN) signin area. If you arrive after hours report to Room 236 at 0630 the following morning for In-Processing.

#### 2. GRADUATION DATE:

a. Graduation for the course will be on the 15th day of your scheduled class. Departure from McCrady Training Center should be scheduled on the 15th day of your class. Students traveling by commercial transportation should schedule departure no earlier than 1300 hrs.

#### 3. MEALS, TRANSPORTATION, BILLETS AND LAUNDRY SERVICE:

- a. Meals: Meals are provided free of cost to students. Meals are not provided free of cost prior to report date. The academy requires all AGR Soldiers attending any course to suspend their separate rations on a DA form 4187. This is to be completed by your unit and turned into your assigned pay office.
- b. **Transportation**: Transportation for students from the Columbia, SC airport, bus station, or train station to the McCrady Training Center will be provided between the duty hours of 0800-1700 on the report date by calling 803-299-2297 or 803-299-4538. While awaiting transportation from the Columbia Metropolitan Airport please stand by at the USO (1-803-822-7953) located at 3250 Airport Blvd Suite #7 West Columbia, SC 29170. If the USO is closed please go downstairs to the baggage claim area and wait for provided transportation if during duty hours. If your arrival time is outside of these duty hours you will be required to utilize public transportation, (Cab Only; Uber is not covered by DTS at this time.) All air travelers should inform airport staff in the baggage claim area your destination is McCrady

Training Center, NOT

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**FORT JACKSON!** All students should arrive **NLT 1200 hours** on the report date.

- c. **Billeting:** All MOS-T students will be required to pay for their billets on the day of arrival. BEQ rooms are \$24.00 a night. If your arrival time will be later than 1500 you must call ahead to reserve your room. Billeting will leave a key to your room at the front gate for those arriving after hours. **We highly recommend you call McCrady Billeting to reserve your room prior to your arrival @ (803) 299-2210. Billeting is not managed by the RTI.** Billeting will take all forms of major credit cards, or cash. However, personal checks will not be accepted. The room charge will be reimbursed through DTS once you return to home station.
- d. **Laundry:** Washing machines and dryers are available free of charge within the billets for use by students.

## 4. Pay / Travel:

- a. **Pay:** Units will process all pay and travel for USAR and ARNG students. If you are released early from this course, the RTI will notify your home unit. Students need to bring sufficient cash to cover personal incidental expenses.
- b. **Travel**: As soon as you receive confirmation of your commercial travel schedule (airline, bus or train schedule) you are required to inform 1<sup>ST</sup> BN (EN), 218<sup>TH</sup> REGT (LDR). Your travel needs to be emailed to: ng.sc.scarng.list.701-1st-bn-en@army.mil. If you fail to submit your commercial travel schedule you can expect a wait of up to 6 hours for transportation to McCrady Training Center. We are not staffed to provide continuous shuttle support from Columbia Metropolitan Airport.

# 5. Recreation:

a. McCrady Training Center is not on Ft. Jackson. It is approximately 10 miles from the main post. The training site does not have the luxuries as a normal installation however, there is a small shoppette that sells basic items that is open Wednesday - Sunday from 1100-1900.

### 6. Course Requirements:

### a. Course Prerequisites:

- A minimum score of 90 in aptitude area CO in Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) tests administered prior to 2 January 2002.
- ii. A minimum score of 87 in aptitude area CO on ASVAB tests administered on and after 2 January 2002.
- iii. Normal Red/Green Color Discrimination

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- iv. A physical profile of 111221.
- v. Physical Demand Rating (Very Heavy)
- vi. Lift occasional over 100 LB frequent 50 LB.
- b. Non-compliance of these mandatory prerequisite will prevent enrollment into the 12B10 course.
- c. In-Processing Documents: All units must ensure that the PRCL in ATRRS is completed at least 72 hours prior to the course start date. If the PRCL is not completed the Soldier will be dis-enrolled from the course automatically. If you have a permanent profile, you must provide a valid copy of DA Form 3349 upon reporting.

IF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTATION IS NOT PROVIDED WITHIN 72HRS OF THE COURSE START DATE, SOLDIERS WILL BE DISENROLLED AND MUST RETURN TO THEIR UNIT OF ASSIGNMENT:

- i. Orders
- ii. DA Form 1610
- iii. Current passing DA 705
- iv. Verify PIN for CAC (Do not send a copy of CAC)

d. Length: 15 days ADT

### 7. Scope:

Provides skill level 1 technical training in demolitions, mobility / countermobility / survivability, fixed bridging, explosive hazards, and urban operations. There is also a series of seven High Physical Demand Tasks that must be completed to standard to meet graduation requirements. These include: a 12 Mile Foot March, Drag a Casualty to Safety (dismounted), Remove a Casualty From a Vehicle (mounted), Prepare an Obstacle with the H6 40 Pound Cratering Charge, Lift and Carry Kettle Bells, Breach a Door using Manual Techniques, Install a U-Shaped Picket.

#### 8. Miscellaneous:

- a. Firearms and any knives with blades exceeding 6in are not permitted.
- b. An ATM at the shoppette and RTI is available.
